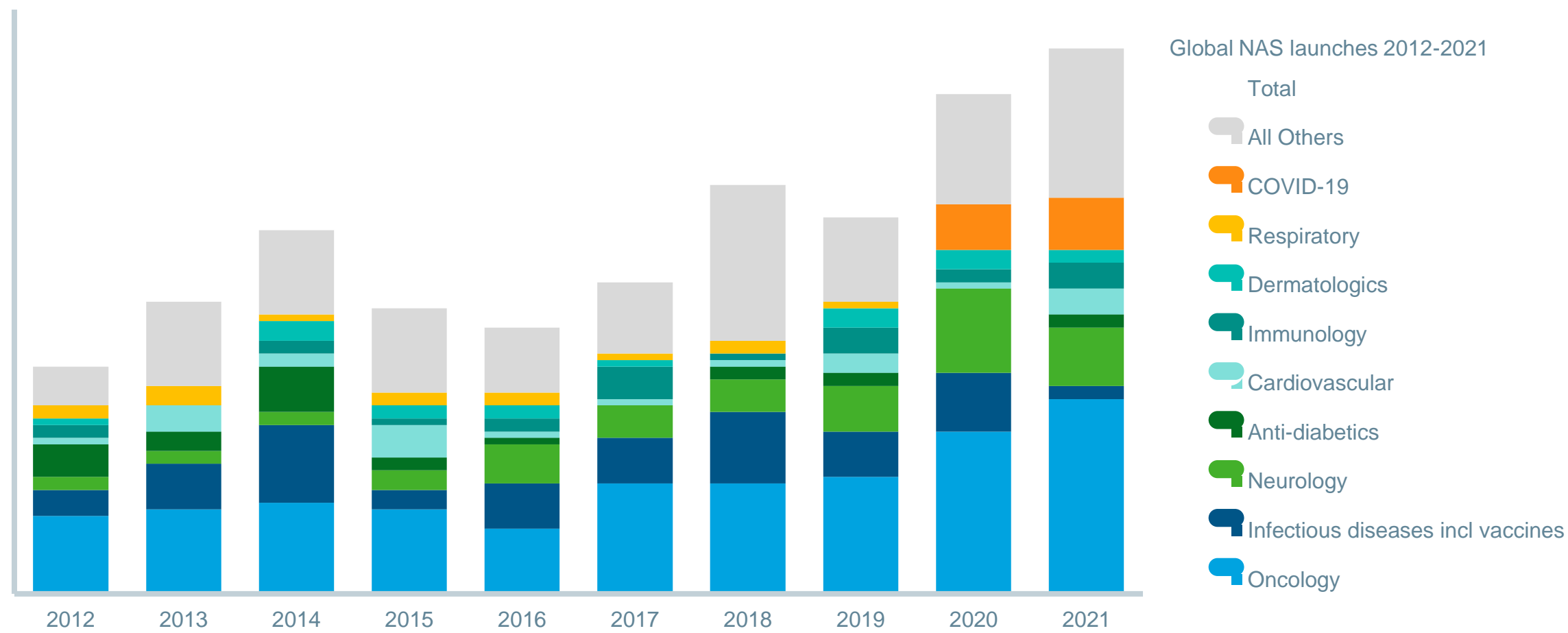

A record number novel active substances (NASs) were launched globally in 2021

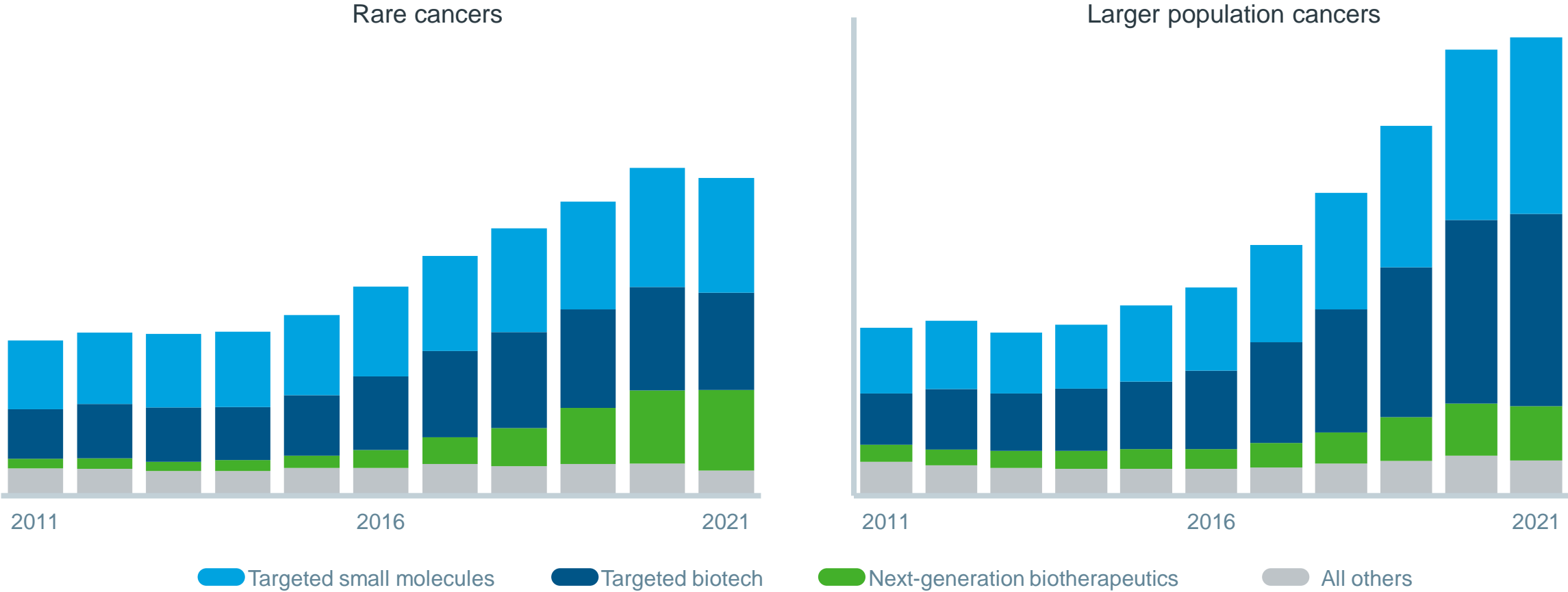
Global launches of novel active substances (NAS) by therapy area, 2011–2021



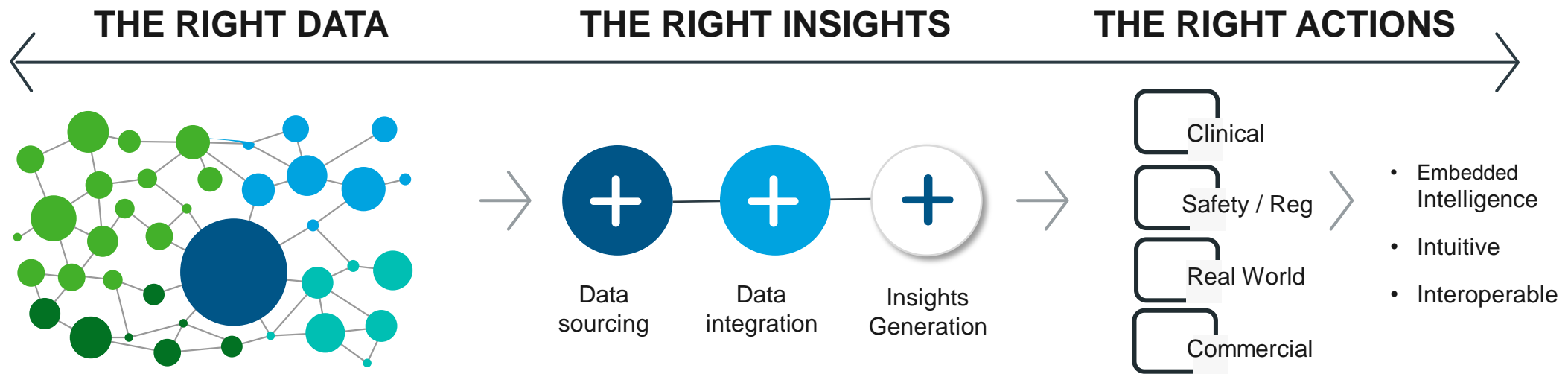

Number of Phase I to regulatory submission oncology pipeline products by type, 2011–2021



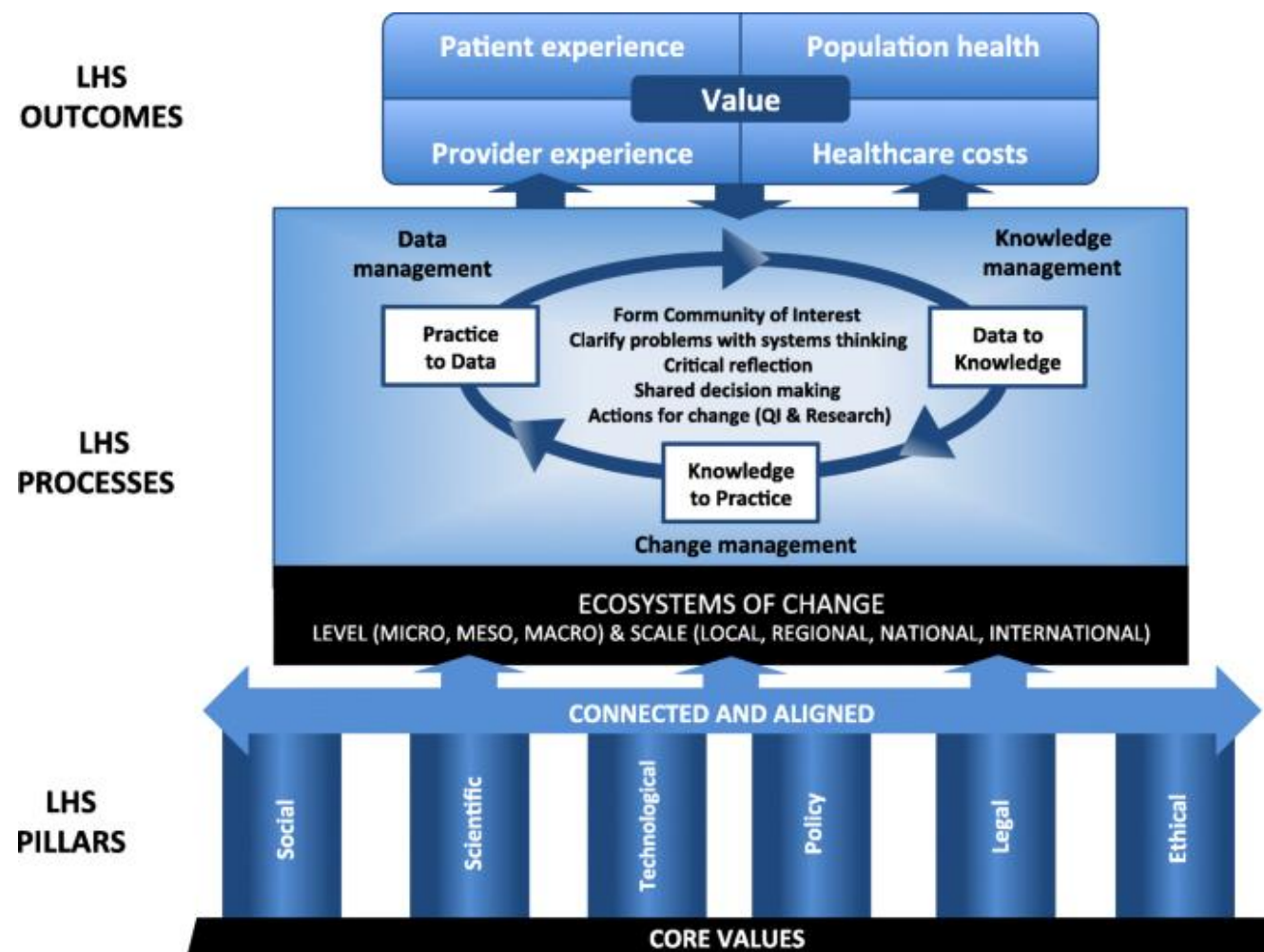

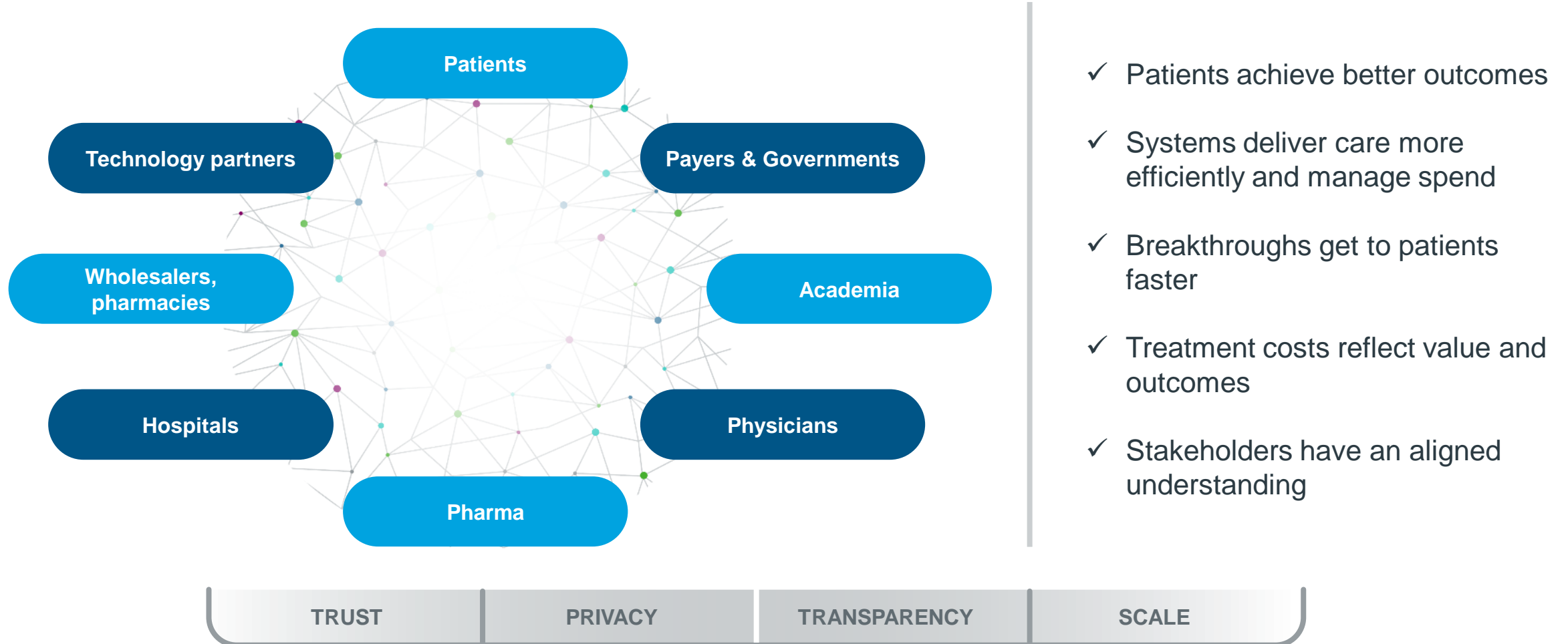
Learning Health Systems Framework
