

Student Travel Bursary Application Guidelines

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Purpose

The CAPT Student Travel Award supports graduate and post-doctoral students by offsetting travel expenses—either fully or partially—related to presenting their research at the CAPT Annual Conference as a first author or primary presenter.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a full-time graduate or post-doctoral student at a recognized institution. Priority will be given to students studying in Canada.
- Be the first author or primary presenter of at least one accepted abstract for the CAPT Annual Conference.

Award Details:

- Recipients may receive a travel bursary of up to **\$1,500**, with a total award fund of **\$20,000**.
- Meeting the eligibility criteria and having an abstract accepted does not guarantee award funding.

Note: The travel bursary amount is determined by the **one-way distance** traveled to attend the CAPT Annual Conference on a **single day**.

Distance Travelled (Km)	Previous Bursary	New Bursary
50 - 200	\$100	\$300

500 - 1000	\$300	\$800
> 1000	\$600	\$1,500

Application Process

To be considered for funding, students must submit a completed application form to the CAPT Secretary via email at admin@capt-actp.ca

Application Deadline

Applications will be accepted based on the deadline or until all available funds have been allocated.

Notification of Award

Applicants will receive an official electronic letter informing them of the funding decision.

Award Disbursement

Travel bursary cheques will be included in the recipient's conference registration package and distributed at the event.
